
Verse 2-3




This isn't about whether women could prophesy or pray—they clearly had the freedom to do so. The issue was about maintaining order and the right heart posture.








Because this became an emblem for modesty and chastity. Presumably women who felt able to uncover their heads were considered immodest, unchaste, and therefore by definition, un-Roman.





Our failure to exercise Biblical authority, and our failure to submit to Biblical authority, isn't just wrong and sad, it sins against the very nature of God.







Examine = to test to see whether a thing is genuine or not


3 types of people:

- 3. Those that make the distinction of both blood and body




Chapter 11
