Verse 3
Defense = apologia - defense against a charge; a charge concerning which some men were judging him as it were in court.

Examine = anakrino - has legal connotations, used in connection with judicial hearings

Shepherd - Supported by the sheep he tends








Chapter 9 - Paul Surrenders His Rights


All passed through the sea, all were baptized into Moses

Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry: In the original language, there is an article before idolatry, literally saying "the idolatry". Paul is specifically referring to the idolatry at the pagan temples.
